3. ANSTO User meeting 2021: 24 – 26 November

- Recently, the ORNL user community recently selected 8 new instruments: https://mailchi.mp/ornl/neutrons-2566068?e=aaa529a54c Over 100 researchers from more than 60 institutions worked with their neutron science colleagues from the Neutron Sciences Directorate and the STS Project to prepare proposals describing compelling science cases that established the requirements for the defined instrument concepts. The proposals were reviewed by an external committee of 22 recognized national and international experts.
