## 2. President report (CW)

Scientific Advisory Committee met at ANSTO and CW presented on behalf of the users recently. Asked how often we conduct surveys, ANSTO does their own through end-of-experiment feedback. Maybe ANBUG should consider holding another survey. Would have to make sure something comes out of it.
